The Hmong Women's Center will be the nation's first dedicated space honoring the stories and triumphs of Hmong women across generations. More than a building, this center will serve as a home for Hmong women's contributions, a gathering place for community, leadership development, and a bridge connecting past, present, and future generations of Hmong women—not just in Minnesota, but all across America.

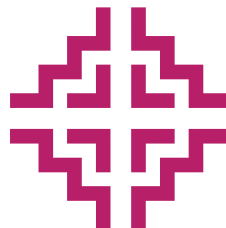

The Hmong Women's Center provides:

A visible space for Hmong women and other groups to partner and network with us, offer learning opportunities, and host programs that advance the status and prosperity of Hmong women.

A home for Hnub Tshiab to deliver and grow its programs by creating space to expand leadership and capacity-building opportunities that activate the leadership capacity of Hmong women and girls.

A catalyst for connection, belonging and social change, the Hmong women's Center will be more than a building—it will serve as a brave space for Hmong women to strengthen and reinforce Hmong women's identity while activating them to lead, advocate, and uplift future generations.

An anchoring location for Hmong women to collect, celebrate, and preserve their stories. By partnering with other community organizations, we will work to collect the stories of Hmong women's resilience and achievements made throughout history and ensure their legacy is recognized for generations to come.

The Need:



Cultural displacement

Only 3.7% of Minnesota's Hmong population over age 65. There is a brief opportunity to preserve their firsthand stories, wisdom, and resilience.



Invisibility of women's contribution

Hmong women's contributions remain largely undocumented and overlooked. Their sacrifices and achievements are too often absent from public history—and, in many cases, untold within the Hmong community itself.



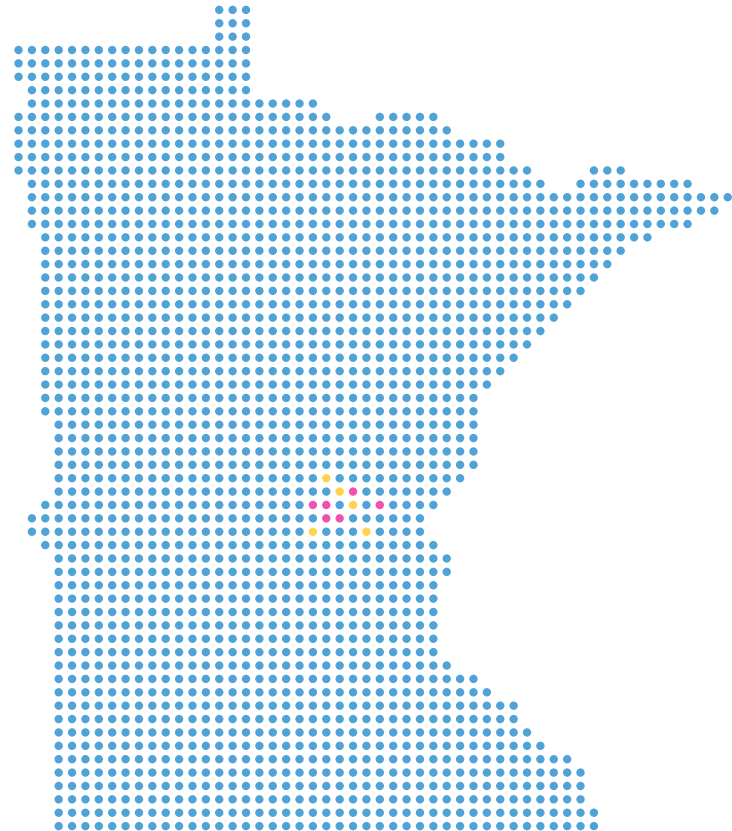
Intergenerational Disconnect

There is a significant generational gap between young people and elders—**38.3% are under the age of 18 with a median age of 19.7.** This gap creates an urgent need to raise the visibility of Hmong women who came before.



Educational transformation without cultural grounding

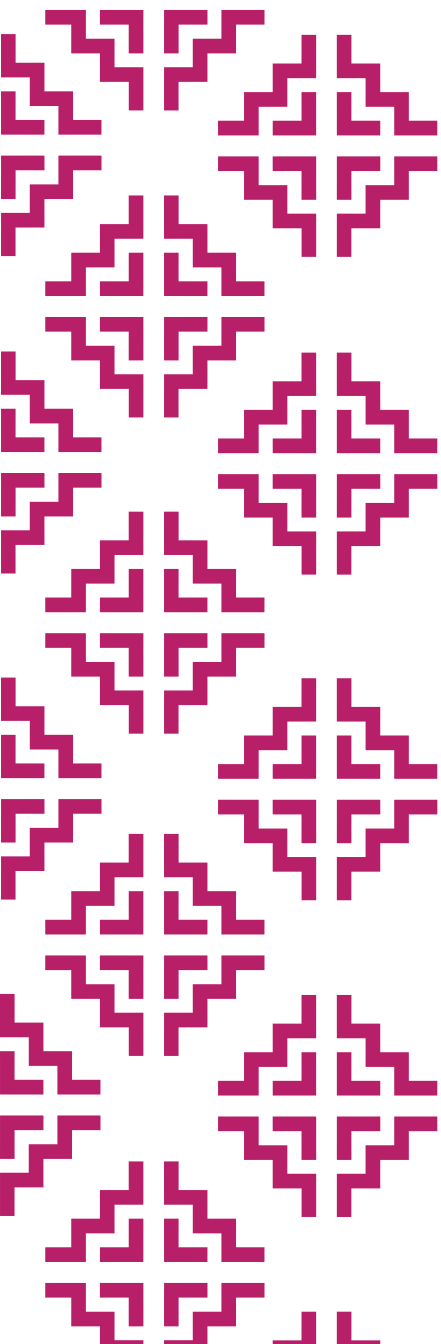
Hmong women's rapid advancement in education has come at a cost of cultural disconnection and a lack of space for young women to learn about their unique identity.

by educating Hmong and non-Hmong communities alike, ensuring their stories become a recognized and celebrated part of America's history.

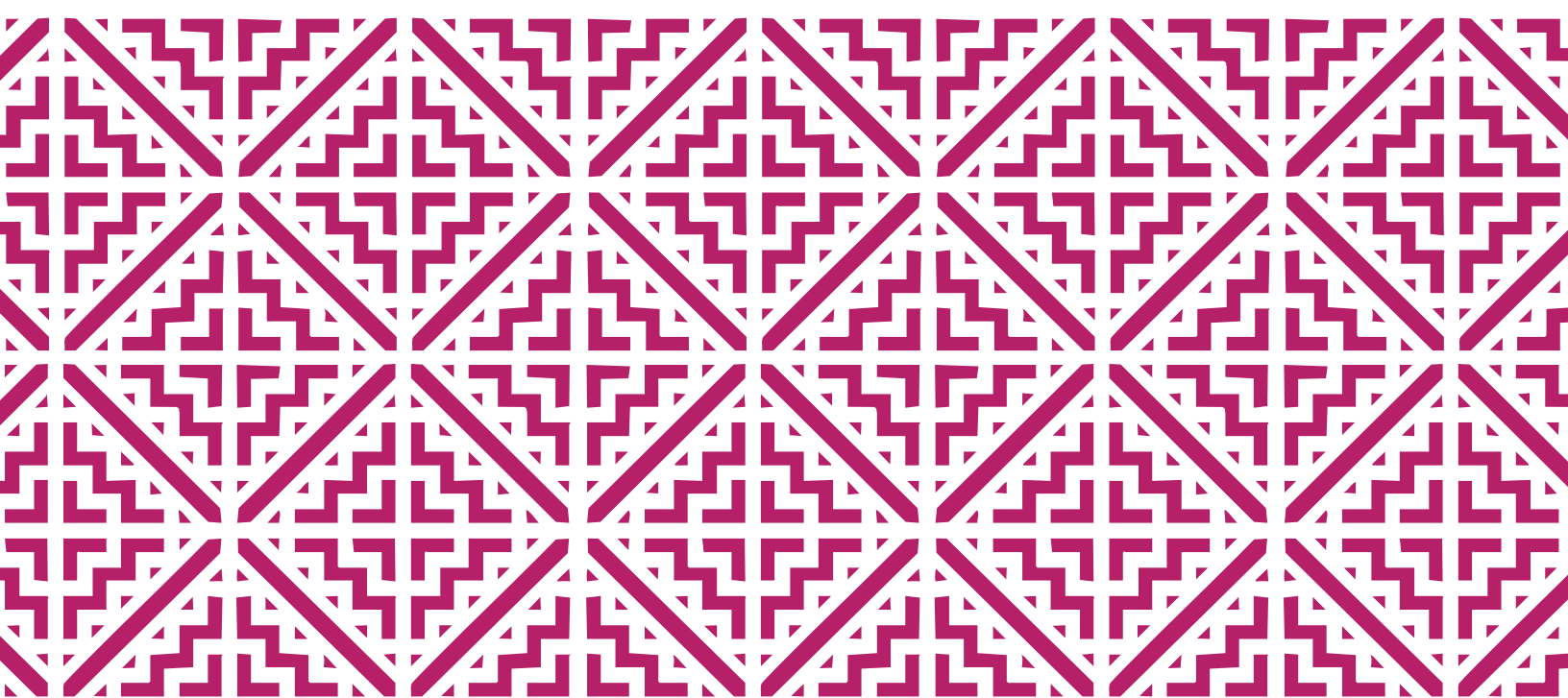
